## Tournament Rules

- All games will be played under Roller Hockey Canada playing rules
- The minimum numbers of players needed to enter a team is 5 (4 skaters and 1 goalie)
- Teams will be formed by the tournament committee to create balanced divisions
- Registered Players have the opportunity to select one friend they would like to play with.
- The maximum number of players per team roster is 6 players (exceptions will be made on case by case basis)
(5 skaters and 1 goalie)
- In the case of injuries or unusual circumstances, teams may affiliate players. But only from a lower division or lower age group
- At the conclusion of the warm-up, a minimum of 4 eligible players in uniform (not necessarily a goalie) on each team shall be necessary to start the game. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN FORFEITURE.
- Players must play a minimum of one round robin game to be eligible for playoff round games
- All suspensions will follow the Roller Hockey Canada suspension guidelines and will be reviewed individually by Tournament Discipline Chair
- Any coach /manager /coaching staff suspended during the tournament will not be permitted to be on any bench until their suspension has been served.
- All protests must be filed in writing and $\$ 100$ cash (refundable if win the protest) within two hours of end of game, to the tournament official residing in the arena where the disputed game is played.
- Event Chair and Committee have full authority to suspend a player, coach or coaching staff member from the event for any verbal or physical abuse to any event staff, official, player or team official.
- Any players receiving a second major of any kind will be ejected from the tournament.
- Any players receiving a major for fighting will be ejected from the tournament.
- In a run time setting, during a penalty, no player from the penalized team may be substituted during a stoppage in play [Rule 19 (h)]
- Teams will be posted on the AMRHA website once finalized
- Team must have a minimum one set of jerseys and must be a similar color. The jerseys the team selects do not require the same logos or labels, just similar color.
- In the event both teams have similar colors the home team will wear the pinnies.
